<u>Choice of Generic Elective Course (GEC) and Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) for</u> students of Semester VI in B.A.(Prog.) and B.Com.(Prog.) in Kirori Mal College.

All students of Semester VI in B.A.(Prog.) and B.Com.(Prog.) in Kirori Mal College are required to submit online their preferences for Generic Elective courses (GECs offered by the college. The BA Programme students should also submit their preferences for the Skill Enhancement Course (SEC). These should be submitted latest by **11:59 PM on Wednesday, 10th January, 2024** in a prescribed e-form accessible at the Kirori Mal College website at the following link:

Important Instructions:

- 1. The students should carefully fill out the form because this form can be submitted only once. Care should be taken in correctly mentioning the name, college roll number, department (in which the student has been admitted), email id, and phone number (please provide an active phone number).
- 2. The students of a particular discipline combination will not be allowed to choose the GEC offered under the same disciplines. For example, the students of BA(Prog) with a discipline combination of Political Science and History are not allowed to choose the GEC offered under Political Science and History. The students who have English or Hindi Discipline as their core discipline cannot choose GEC offered by English or Hindi departments respectively. Similarly, the students of B.Com (Prog) are not allowed to choose the GEC offered by the Commerce department.
- 3. Students are advised to provide three choices of GEC in order of preference. Though we will attempt to provide the student's first choice, we may not be able to do so, given the number of applicants in a course. (The list of the GECs offered by the college is mentioned below and also available as a dropdown list in the form.)
- 4. Students of BA(Prog) are also advised to provide a choice of SEC. (The list of the SECs offered by the college is mentioned below and also available as a dropdown list in the form.) The choice of SEC in the fifth semester is independent

of the choices made in the earlier semesters. All BA (P) students should fill out the form for SEC irrespective of whether they intend to choose the same subject as their SEC, as in the last semester, or not.

5. If a student fails to submit the online form by the notified last date, she/he may be allotted a course at the discretion of the college.
