

Notice for the choice of Common Courses (GEC, SEC, VAC, AEC) for Semester-III 2023 [for BA (Prog.) and B.Com (Prog.) students only]

All Semester III students of BA and B.Com Programme please note that they have to choose their Generic Elective Course (GEC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC), Value Addition Course (VAC) and Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) by filling out a Google form, the link for which is given below.

The last date for filling the Google forms is 07.08.2023.

Please note the following points:

- The students should carefully fill out the form because this form can be submitted only once. Care should be taken in correctly mentioning the name, college roll number, examination roll number, e-mail id and phone number (please provide your own active phone number).
- BA Programme students will mandatorily pursue English GEC this semester (except for those who have English Discipline as a core subject).
- All (i) B.Com Programme students and (ii) BA Programme students who have English Discipline as one of their core subjects (with the exception of cases mentioned in the next point) will mandatorily pursue Hindi GEC this semester. The level at which they will pursue Hindi GEC will depend on the level to which they have studied Hindi in school. Please note that B.Com (Prog.) students, who have already pursued Hindi GEC in Semester I cannot change the level (A, B or C) in Semester III from what was earlier pursued in Semester I.
- However all such students of (i) B.Com. Programme and (ii) BA Programme (with English Discipline) who have not studied Hindi up to Class VIII or beyond or have not studied it at all in school (including all foreign students) are to choose their GEC from the common pool. However, while selecting their GEC from the common pool they cannot choose the GECs offered by the departments of their core disciplines. So, B.Com students cannot choose Commerce GEC from the common pool and BA programme students with English and Political Science/History as their core disciplines cannot choose English and Political Science/History as their GEC from the common pool. All such students opting for a GEC from the common pool have to provide three choices of GE courses in order of preference. Though our attempt will be to provide the student's first choice, we may not always be able to do so, given the number of applicants in a course. (The list of the GECs offered by the college is available as a dropdown list in the form.)
- The students **cannot** choose in Semester III exactly the same SEC or VAC, that they have taken in Semesters I or II.
- Some courses are sequel courses like Vedic Mathematics (I, II and III) and NCC (I, II). Only those students who have taken the level I course can take the level II course. Similarly, only those who have taken both levels I and II, can take level III. The NCC course can be taken only by the students who are enrolled in NCC in the college.
- All BA and B.Com Programme students will mandatorily pursue Environmental Science (EVS) as their AEC in Semester III.
- All students who want to pursue any SEC or VAC outside the college (for non-availability of such a course in the college) should indicate that in the form. They will have to register their names with the cluster colleges through an application to be mailed to the Committee for the Common Courses at the following mail id: gekmc20@gmail.com. In this mail, the students should mention their name, phone number, roll number and the course that they want to pursue outside the college.
- Students may also opt for a choice between SEC-3 or Internship/ Apprenticeship/ Project/ Community Outreach (IAPC) (Subject to approval). Specifics about this will be notified later once the University finalizes the details.
- If a student fails to submit the online form by the notified last date, she/he may be allotted a course at the discretion of the college.
