





The five-day long webinar analysed the philosophy and methodology implicit in Mahatma Gandhi's century old journey which is still relevant. Mahatma Gandhi, the Father of the Nation has inspired generations, not just in India but all over the world to walk on the path of peaceful conflict resolution. Martin Luther King Jr., Dalai Lama, Nelson Mandela, Khan Abdul Ghaffar Khan, Aung San Suu Kyi are just to name a few who have acknowledged the influence of Mahatma Gandhi in shaping them. With the massive build-up of instruments of mass destruction, mankind is facing a real threat of total annihilation. In this context, the life and vision of Mahatma Gandhi is more relevant today than ever before, especially in the arena of peace and conflict resolution. The webinar offered a scholarly, critical, and nuanced perspective on Gandhi, who is increasingly being studied as a philosopher, religious thinker, and critic of industrial modernity. The webinar provided an ideal opportunity to upheld and renew Gandhi's ideals for the promotion of his principles of nonviolence, tolerance and justice, and for a focus on the problems of the poor and needy in the world. The five-day long event, consisted of 4 lectures covering various aspects of Gandhian principles. The last day of the webinar was open for the participants who had attended the lecture series on Gandhian principles. This facilitated the participants to share their understanding and interact with fellow participants as well. More than 200 participants enthusiastically listened through the deliberations over the 5 days.
